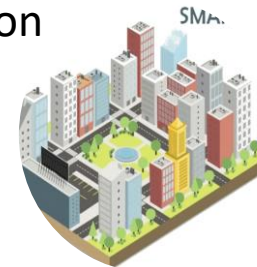
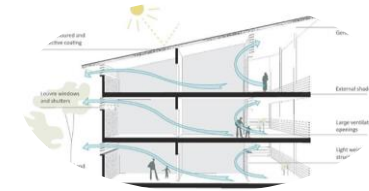
Getting Cooling Right!

It's not just about the equipment



Policies and Regulations are also required. Policies for:

- (1) Avoiding or reducing the need for cooling in buildings
- (2) Increasing the thermal efficiency of buildings e.g. building codes
- (3) For Urban Planning: district cooling, green roofs
- (4) facilitating funding and financial mechanisms for market transformation
- (5) Smart investments and technology upgrades in the manufacture of cooling applicates with improved COP/EE/SEER
- (6) New financing and business models to promote sustainable cooling e.g. Cooling as a Service (CAAS)
- (7) Public education and outreach to aid in technology choices
- (8) Public sector procurement, e.g. green procurement, bulk procurement
- (9) Training and Capacity development of RAC technicians



Grenada's Policy and Legislative Approach

- Policy and Legislative Review and Update. Three approaches:
 - (1) Situation analysis and baseline study
 - Policy Gap analysis and strategy report
 - (2) Implementation and Enforcement Plan
 - (3) Monitoring and Evaluation Plan

 - Energy Efficiency labelling standards for RAC equipment
- **Capacity Development and training**
 - Green cooling

 - Establishment of a regional training centre for Natural refrigerant (HC) technology
- **Public Awareness and Education**
 - Green cooling communication strategy
 - Virtual Technology Roadshows
 - Development of PA material and informercials
- **Fiscal and economic incentives**
 - Import tax reductions on NatRef Acs
- **GHG Inventory for the RAC Sector**
- **Establishment of a National Cooling Action Plan (NCAP)**
